



Su Lui, M.D., Ph.D.

Dr Lui is currently a professor of Radiology, the Vice Chair of Department of Radiology, and the Vice director of Huaxi Magnetic Resonance Research Center at West China Hospital/ West China Medical School of Sichuan University.

Dr Lui has been offered the Chang Jiang distinguished professor of the Ministry of Education, the Friedrich Wilhelm Bessel Research Award of the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation, the Shu-Lan Medicine Youth Award for Physician Scientists, the E. K. Zavoisky Award of ISMRM and et al in recognition of his outstanding accomplishments in the field of Psychoradiology.

Dr Lui's research emphasis has been in applying multimodal MRI to investigate structural and functional brain alterations in psychiatric disorders, especially schizophrenia. Dr Lui is also actively using deep learning, immune and multimodal imaging to identify subgroups of individuals with schizophrenia that have similar phenotypes suggesting discrete forms of neurobiological alteration. Dr Lui has published over 165 peer-reviewed journal articles, such as JAMA Psychiatry, Journal of American Psychiatry, Radiology, and Neuroimage. Dr Lui has a H-index factor of 44 and 28000+ total citations on Google Scholar.

Dr Lui chaired session of *Recent Advances in MRI Studies of Schizophrenia* at the conference of American College of Neuropsychopharmacology (ACNP) in 2018. In particular, Dr Lui has served as a committee member of ISMRM since 2007 and long been a participant as well as contributor to ISMRM/ OCSMRM. Dr Lui has also regularly given educational course at the conferences of ISMRM. If selected, Dr Lui will continue promoting the development of OCSMRM and young Chinese researchers in the field of MRI.
